### **Wisconsin Hereford Association Female Grant Program**

## **Purpose**

The purpose of this grant is to assist WJHA youth members in purchasing a Hereford female to start building their own herd. The WHA would also like to encourage youth to participate in the Wisconsin Hereford Association Spring Sale. The grants will be funded by the Wisconsin Hereford Association and the consignors of the Wisconsin Spring Sale. There will be two \$500 grants awarded. Of the two grants, the consignor-sponsored grant can be used only at the Wisconsin Spring Sale. The WHA-sponsored grant could be used to purchase a Hereford female from any WHA member in good standing, and may be used at any date before December 31, 2024.

# Eligibility

- 1. Youth must be a current member of the Wisconsin Junior Hereford Association. (Annual membership fee of \$10 may be sent with the grant application)
- 2. Age: Must be at least 7 years old on January 1, 2024 and not older than 22 years on January 1, 2024, as set forth by the National Junior Hereford Association.
- 3. If awarded the Wisconsin Spring Sale grant, youth must purchase a registered Hereford female from the Wisconsin Hereford Spring Sale on March 2, 2024 at the Fennimore Livestock Exchange. This grant is not transferable to any other member or sale. If not used, it will be withdrawn.
- 4. If awarded the WHA grant, youth must purchase a registered Hereford female from a WHA member in good standing by December 31, 2024
- 5. Recipient(s) of the grant may not transfer the female to any other person or breeder for one (1) year.
- 6. Recipient(s) are strongly encouraged to be present at the Wisconsin Hereford Spring Sale.
- 7. Recipient(s) must have the means to provide the remaining funds required to purchase a female.
- 8. Recipient(s) will receive a grant check from the Wisconsin Hereford Association for \$500. For the Consignor-sponsored grant, recipient will pay full purchase price for the animal at the WHA Spring Sale. For the WHA-Sponsored grant, recipient will pay full purchase price for Hereford female purchased from WHA member in good standing.
- 9. Grant recipient(s) are invited to attend the following year's WHA Annual Meeting banquet to provide a follow-up report on their purchase and experience.

#### **Selection Process**

- 1. Grant application must be received to WHA Board Member Kelly Oleson, via email, no later than February 27, 2024. Kelly's Email Address is: oleson.kelly@gmail.com
- 2. Selection committee will be comprised of the 2 WHA board members and WHA consignor.
- 3. Grant recipients will be notified shortly after the deadline.
- 4. Grant recipients will be recognized at the beginning of the Wisconsin Hereford Association Spring Sale.
- 5. The female purchased with grant funds must be transferred to the grant recipient's name when settlement is made on sale day.
