# Sale Results

With the Covid-19 issues going on, the 2021 National Western Stock Show and the Ft. Worth Stock Show were both cancelled. The American Hereford Association Board of Directors made a great decision by designating the Inaugural Cattlemen's Congress in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, a National Hereford Show in 2021. Many thanks to the Cattlemen's Congress Committee, their staff, Kevin Stitt, governor of Oklahoma, along with Mr. Bob Funk and Mr. Jerald Callahan of Express Ranch for making this a FIRST CLASS EVENT.

Here are some facts from the first Cattlemen's Congress:

- There were 85 Hereford bulls shown, 307 Hereford females shown, 8 Pen of 3 heifers shown, 4 Pen of 5 bulls shown, and 12 Pen of 3 bulls shown.
- The Cattlemen's Congress National Hereford Sale seen 14 bulls average \$32,250, 7 bred heifers average \$15,393, 11 open heifers average \$9,932, and 8 Pick of the Herd lots average \$14,125.

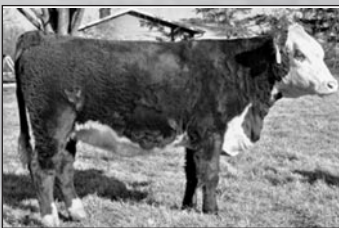

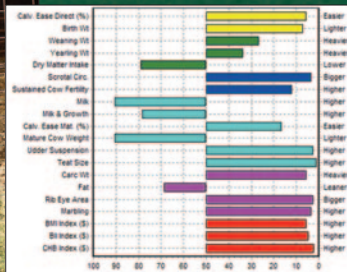

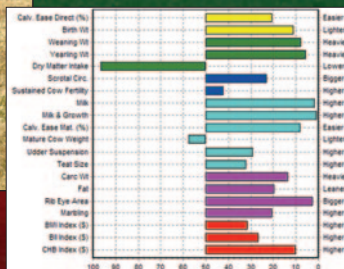
