2021 NJHA Fed Steer Shootout

KANSAS CITY, Mo. — Now in its fifth year, the National Junior Hereford Association's (NJHA) Fed Steer Shootout contest teaches juniors about the opportunities and challenges of the cattle feeding industry. In the 2021 contest, 41 members from 15 states entered 133 steers in the program.
